The big machines are constructed to carry out specific tasks in the most efficient manner for each industry. Larger machine is usually utilized outdoors to grade land and clear areas to prepare for construction.

There are various projects that need the expertise of a heavy equipment operator, like for instance public works projects and endeavors of privately owned businesses. Jobs completed by public works offices may consist of construction of roads and the construction of bridges. There are numerous other publicly funded projects which comprise dam construction, airport runways, power plants, municipal structures and levees. Private projects could consist of the construction of office buildings, malls, industrial parks and retail stores.

Some of the smaller scale tasks require equipment made of the use inside big industrial spaces or in commercial buildings. Usually, the machine selection comprises pallet jacks, forklifts and cherry pickers. Trenchers and backhoes are normally available in different sizes appropriate for tasks requiring powerful and less bulky equipment.

Operators of heavy equipment will be required to be certified by their local or regional agency. Many of these operators are cross-trained and certified to operate many different models of heavy machines. Other operators choose to specialize in operating only one kind of machine and only require periodic updates on their operating permit certifications.

Workers in this business are usually trained through a formal apprenticeship course offered by unions or companies or else with on-the-job training. Some trade and technical schools provide paid training courses. It is necessary that employers hire fully-trained heavy equipment operators to be able to adhere to local rules and follow local and regional laws regarding job conditions and worker safety.
